EXAMINATION DAYS AND INCLEMENT WEATHER

On examination days, if the rural school buses are not running due to inclement weather, examinations for that day will be delayed until the first day the rural buses are running again.

For example, if on January 23, the rural buses were not running, this day's examinations would be postponed until January 26, with all subsequent examination days advanced one school day as well.

If the city schools are open, Central will be open for study purposes during examination days. You should listen to radio station CJCS to learn if the rural school buses are running on any particular day.

1. If you miss an examination because of illness, you must provide a note from your parent/guardian. A medical certificate may be required. The school should be notified **prior** to the time of the exam.
2. If you have an exam conflict, complete an Examination Conflict Report by Wednesday, January 14. These forms are available in the Main office.
3. If you arrive late for an exam, report immediately to the office.

AS WELL, IT IS EACH STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY....

- a) to know the dates and times of his/her examinations and to be present and punctual. Read the schedule carefully!
- b) to be prepared for the examinations.
- c) to give full attention **ONLY** to his/her own examination work.

- d) to obey all the directions and instructions of the presiding teacher(s) in the exam room.
