For this semester, a similar procedure has been implemented. **Reports will only be generated for students who are struggling academically and/or not working to their potential in class.** Specific information will be available on this report that will assist students on steps to take to be more successful. **Students are encouraged to meet with/conference with his/her teacher(s) regarding the information on the report.**

If a report is not generated for a student in a course, then there are no concerns regarding progress in that course.

Progress reports will be mailed to parents prior to Parent-Teacher Night.

Parent-Teacher Night for parents/guardians of Grade 9-12 students will occur at Stratford Central on Thursday, March 30 (6-8 pm). We encourage all parents/guardians to attend this evening to meet with individual teachers to discuss the progress of their son/daughter. Please bring along your son/daughter as well, if you wish.

Our next provincial report card will be issued on April 28th. On this date, students will receive their mid-semester report cards.
